Grab a bucket on your way into worship and return when service is over. Each bucket contains wiki sticks, crayons and quiet materials, in case a little ones mind wanders during the service. Children's Church (for 3 and 4 year olds) will continue in Room 106.

DISASTER RELIEF REQUEST FOR FLOOD BUCKETS

The North Georgia District UMCOR (United Methodist Committee On Relief) sent 400 flood buckets to the Nashville area to support their recovery from the recent flood in that area. If you helped make a flood bucket after the floods in Cobb County last September, it is likely the bucket you made has been used in Nashville. The flood buckets are used to help in cleanup immediately after the water recedes. Because they are needed on very short notice, they need to be stockpiled for quick response. The North Georgia UMCOR has seriously depleted the stockpile of flood buckets and there is a need to replenish them in order to be ready when another flood event happens. We ask that you consider providing one or more buckets from your family. It is estimated that each bucket with its contents will cost about \$55. Bring the flood buckets to Mt. Zion and they will be taken to UMCOR. Instructions for preparing a flood bucket are located at the Church's Main Information Bulletin Board and also at the Outreach Committee Bulletin Board. Thank you.

Cleaning Bucket

Estimated Cost: \$55 per kit

KIT CONTENTS

- 5-gallon bucket with re-sealable lid
- Bleach (two 1-quart or one 82 oz. bottle.
- 5 scouring pads
- 7 sponges
- 1 scrub brush
- 18 cleaning towels (reusable wipes)
- Liquid laundry detergent (two 25 oz. or one 50 oz. bottle)
- 1 household cleaner, 12-16 oz. bottle
- Disinfectant dish soap, 16-28 oz. bottle
- 50 clothes pins
- Clothes line (two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.)
- 5 dust masks
- 2 pair latex gloves
- 1 pair work gloves
- 24-bag roll of heavy-duty trash bags, 33-45 gallon (remove roll from box before placing in bucket)
- 1 Insect repellent spray, 6-14 oz. can (If aerosol, cans must have protective caps. See Special Requirements below.)
- 1 Air freshener, 8 or 9 oz. can (If aerosol, cans must have protective caps.)

Important Kit Assembly Information

All items included in kits must be NEW items.

All emergency kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules often govern product entry into international countries, it is important that kits contain only the requested items—nothing more.

Please do NOT include any personal notes, money or additional materials in the kits. These things must be painstakingly removed and will delay the shipment.

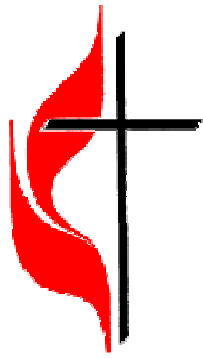
